

PART-TIME JOB OPPORTUNITY WITH THE MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGY CENTER

The MTC is seeking a part-time *Environmental Consultant* to provide services to our clients in Virginia funded by the EPA under the P2 (pollution prevention) grant.

Services will include on-site assessments of the client's environmental footprint including waste streams, air and water emissions, storm water runoff, permitting, recycling, spill prevention, etc. On-site work is followed by the creation of a report summarizing all findings and recommendations.

The goal is to help the client reduce their environmental impacts, save money, and be in full compliance with all laws and regulations.

Other services might include providing support to clients who need assistance understanding DEQ and EPA regulations and what they need to do to be in compliance. These questions are typically submitted by clients via phone or email.

The consultant will also be providing short seminars and training sessions on environmental related topics of interest to industries in VA. All work is performed in a completely confidential manner with findings and recommendations shared only with the client.

The ideal person will have significant education and experience related to environmental compliance as it relates to Virginia manufacturing sites.
